MEMORANDUM OF THE CONVOCAATION OF THE BOARD AND GENERAL ASSEMBLY

Bologna (Italy), 1st November, 2017.

In accordance with the convocation of Bureau and General Assembly of CIGH of 2nd June 2017 at Montreal, both the meetings were regularly held there on 19th June 2017. For the 1st time the Americans Associations had the opportunity to participate and express their thoughts.

Following that summons I am today to convoke again in Copenhagen the Bureau and General Assembly as indicated in the past convocation of 2nd June 2017.

Unluckily, both for other concurrent events that forbid the participation of all the members of CIGH present in the XX International Colloquium of Heraldry and for the difficulty of finding an adequate room for this meeting in the same seat of the Colloquium I am obliged to convoke both Bureau and General Assembly to reopen and close their works with the same program indicated in the past convocation of 2nd June 2017 (see the convocation of 2nd June 2017).

The meetings will be held on Saturday 11th of November 2017 during the lunch (12 a.m.-1.30 p.m.) in a seat I will indicate the day before.

I trust in a wide participation because it is necessary to talk about the future of CIGH which from a simple organization composed the most part by associations who organized Congresses, beginning from the presidency of *Michel Teillard d'Eyry* expanded its confines through new organizations of great importance in their own States not only in Europe, Australia and America but also in Africa and in a next future in Asia.

Among its purposes CIGH grants awards for the most eminent scholars of Documentary Sciences of History, patronizes heraldic and genealogical events with the Universities, and with those organizations bringing on activities of international relevance in their Countries, supports courses of genealogy and heraldry with the specialized schools on these matter and at last informs its members through the half-yearly CIGH Bulletin and also more than 3000 associations in the world about what is made by the various associations members of CIGH.
